## Emergency Checklist - PETS

### **Making Preparations:**

- Vaccinations are current
- Records are in the kit and in a waterproof container or on a USB drive. (Shelters may require proof of vaccinations).
- Have a current photograph and detailed descriptions of your pets to help others identify them in case you and your pets become separated and to prove ownership. (Having a picture of you with your pet may be useful.)
- Collar has tags with accurate contact information
- Leash is sturdy and in working condition.
- Pet carrier for each pet is large enough for the animal to stand and turn around.
- Your disaster evacuation plan includes your pet including: Specialized pet shelters, animal control shelters, veterinary clinics and friends and relatives out of harm's way are ALL potential refuges for your pet during a disaster.

### **Pet Preparedness Kit**

- Easy carry bag or box including the following:
  - Medications,
  - Medical records
  - Vet contact information
  - First aid kit (pet & personal)
  - Sturdy leashes, harnesses, muzzle
  - Extra collar
  - Food and water for at least 72 hours for each pet,
  - Food & water bowls,
  - cat litter and litter box,
  - Manual can opener
  - Feeding schedule
  - Information on medical conditions, behavior problems

### **Other Useful Items to Include:**

- newspapers,
- heavy duty paper towels,
- bio hazard bag with tie,
- grooming items,
- Disinfectant (Dephyze)
- Favorite toy
